Safer Internet Day Tuesday 11 February

Each year in February across the globe Safer Internet Day is a day of action dedicated to raising awareness of online safety. Updated Self Assessment Tool

The Safeguarding Committee has completed the Commission for Children and Young People's 'Understanding cultural safety for Aboriginal children and young people' tool. It shows that we have and display appropriate resources to support Aboriginal children and young people but that we need to make stronger connections with local Aboriginal people and agencies.

Well informed practice for supporting our Indigenous community is an increased part of the self assessment tool. For our Parish, we can also use this tool as the basis of our practice for other marginalised groups.
